Construction of New Grocery Store in Downtown Moncton set for Spring

The construction of a new Sobeys grocery store in Downtown Moncton is expected to start this spring at the corner of Vaughan Harvey Boulevard and Main Street. Shoppers can expect a deli, a full produce section, a meat and seafood counter, a floral department and likely a pharmacy. The store will also include an NB Liquor outlet. The store should look different than a typical Sobeys because of requirements put on the corporation by city officials to make the exterior more eye-catching. The new Sobeys will likely have a green space between the sidewalk and the building, and brick on its side facing the road. It will also be bigger than the current store open at Highfield Square, which is only 21,000 square feet. About 30 to 50 new employees will be hired to staff it. There are no official plans for the old Sobeys location yet.



Atlantic Ballet Theatre of Canada to move to former YMCA location

The Atlantic Ballet Theatre of Canada will soon have a new home in the quarters of the former YMCA at 68 Highfield St. The move from the company's original space at 16 Church Street is planned for this summer. The dance

company will benefit from 7,500 square feet of space, two large dance studios, dressing rooms, office space, a rooftop terrace and floating atrium. Other tenants could fill the remaining several thousand square feet this spring.
