The purpose of the proposed change is to expand the Business Improvement Area to include the St. George Street business area as requested by DMCI as follows: east of *Vaughan Harvey*; south of *Park Street* (*Vaughan Harvey* to *High Street*); south of *Dufferin* (*High* to *Archibald*); south of *Austin* (*Robinson* to *Church*); east of the railway line, north to *Mountain Road*; west of *Botsford Street*; north of *St. George* (adjacent non residential properties) to west of *King Street*; south of *Harper Lane*; west of *Hall's Creek* to the *Petitcodiac River*. A meeting to consider written objections to the proposed changes will be held on **Monday, November 5, 2007 at 6:00 p.m.** in the Council Chambers at City Hall, 655 Main Street, Moncton, NB. The proposed amending by-law may be viewed by any interested person on any day, Monday to Friday, between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. at the City Clerk's Office, 655 Main Street, Moncton, NB, or by viewing our website at www.moncton.ca. Any person who wishes to speak for or against the written objections is entitled to be heard. Objections shall be addressed to the City Clerk, 655 Main Street, Moncton, NB, E1C 1E8, and shall be presented **no later than Wednesday, October 31, 2007 at 4:30 p.m.**
