## Phantom of the Opera back on the Capitol stage

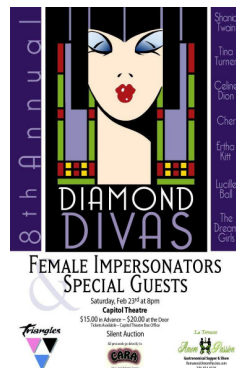
