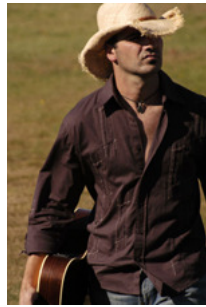

## DID YOU KNOW?

**Moncton Youth Residences Inc, and Youth Quest Central, located at 199 St. George Street, served over 643 at-risk youth** in the last fiscal year.

- They operate 17 different programs, most of which are in the Moncton area.
- They employ approximately 150 staff
- Over 2700 visits to Youth QUEST Central (drop-in for homeless and at-risk youth) in the 2007 calendar year....food was accessed 800 times, showers and hygiene products were accessed 400 times, over 200 loads of laundry were washed by youth in need and over 100 youth accessed our small clothes depot.
